If elected, I promise to give you, the Community, my whole heart and soul to make this district a place for your families and businesses to thrive!

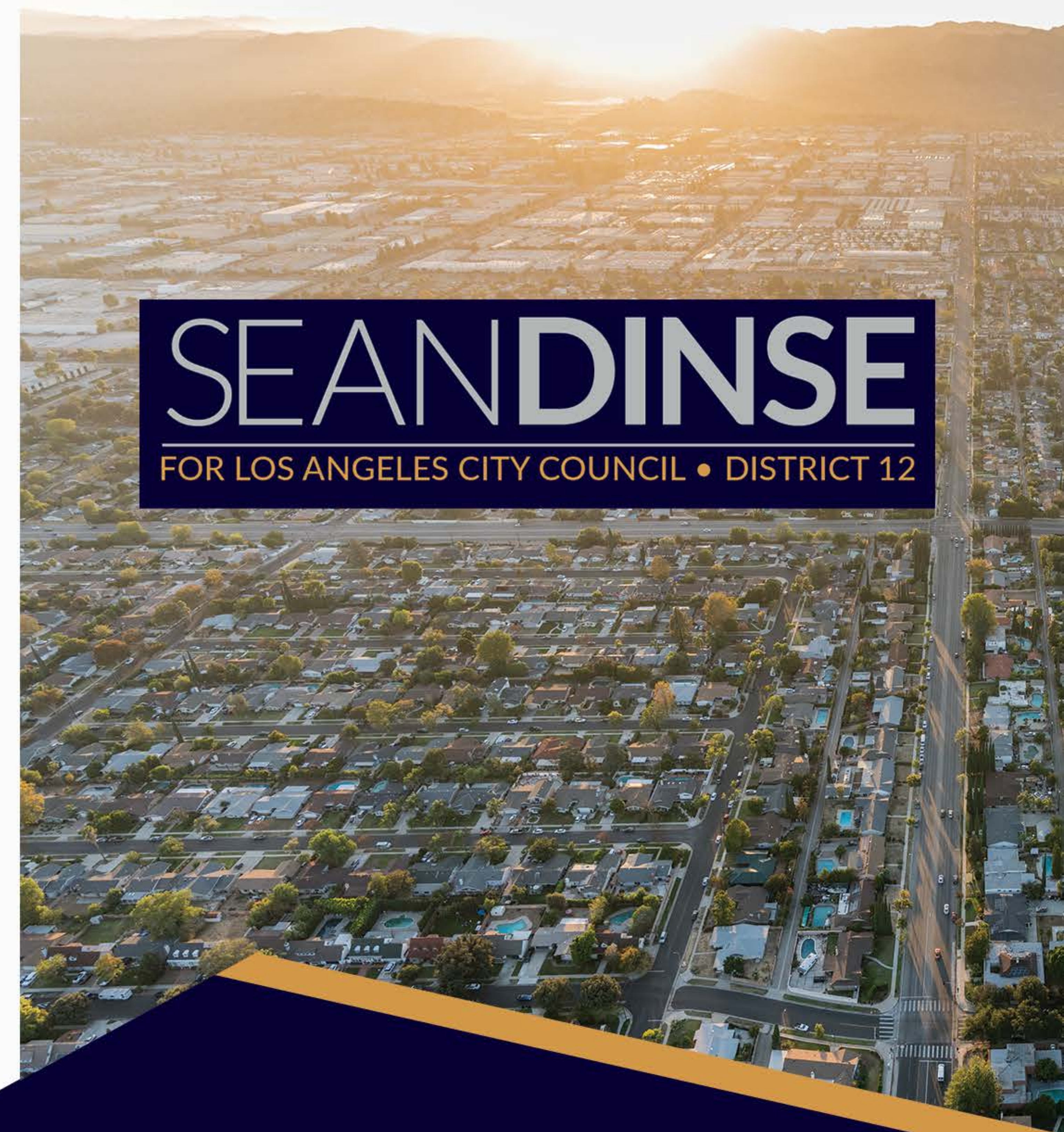
